IMPORTANT TO KNOW:

- Please push the STOP button to indicate that you want to get off at the next stop in good time, to allow the bus driver to stop safely.
- No eating or drinking is allowed on the bus.
- Tickets must be brought for children aged six and above.
- Fare evasion is a form of theft and a criminal offence.
- NMB Municipality determines all routes, schedules, stops and bus types. Drivers are not authorised to deviate from the schedule or designated bus stops or routes.
- Concession - Tickets are for pensioners and scholars in uniform only.
- Police in uniform travel for free.
- Transfer from modes should happen within 30 minutes.
 - Valid until 30 June



TICKETING INFORMATION

There are two (2) basic types of ticket:

- Tickets for the local or feeder routes
- Tickets for the trunk or main route

In each of these types there are:

- Single ride tickets
- Two ride tickets for return trips
- Twelve (12) ride tickets for return trips for a six (6) day week

In addition, discounted concession tickets are available for:

- Scholars - Must be in school uniform to qualify
- Pensioners - Must show their pensioner card
- Students - Must present a valid student card

Route T30: Cleary Park to Lillian Diedericks building is the main route and codes G, H, I, J, K and L are accepted on this route. The articulated Libhongoletu buses will operate on this route.

Routes 340: William Slammert (Boosens Park) to Cleary Park, **341:** Baatjies Street to Cleary Park, and **347:** Kleinskool to Cleary Park are the feeder or local routes and codes A, B, C, D, E and F are accepted on these routes. Branded Libhongoletu minibuses will operate on these routes.

The tickets have no expiry dates. However, after the annual price increase on 1 July, old value tickets will be accepted for a limited period only.

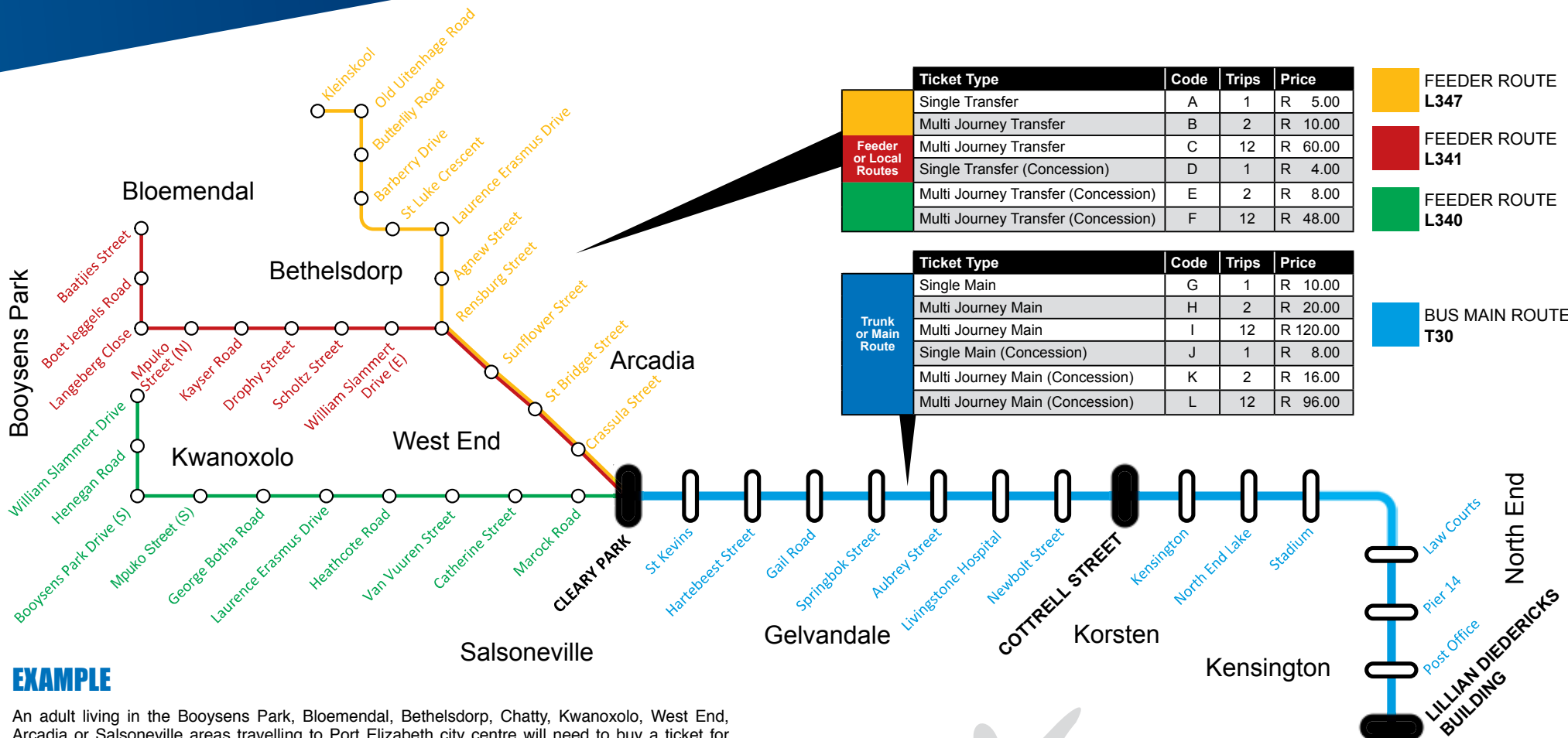

EXAMPLE

An adult living in the Booyensens Park, Bloemendal, Bethelsdorp, Chatty, Kwanoxolo, West End, Arcadia or Salsoneville areas travelling to Port Elizabeth city centre will need to buy a ticket for the feeder/local route and a ticket for the main/trunk route. The possible combination will be an A (R5.00) code ticket and a G (R10.00) code ticket, for a total cost of R15.00. If this person wants to travel for a whole week then they will need to purchase code C and I tickets for R60.00 and R120.00 respectively, a total cost of R180.00.

LIBHONGOLETHU RULES

- No eating, drinking, chewing gum or smoking allowed.
- No littering – please use the bins provided.
- No animals permitted, except service dogs for the visually impaired.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- All unattended bags will be removed.
- No firearms, weapons or dangerous and flammable substances allowed.
- No informal traders.
- Begging, loitering and gambling prohibited.
- No unauthorised advertising or vandalism.
