##### **Purpose**

- Supply, repair and install new shed net in a shade house 1,2& 8.
- Supply and install existing shade net over a carport.

##### **Background**

- New Installation of fibreglass carport roof sheets.
- Welding of six (6) steel containers.

#### **DESCRIPTION OF WORKS**

##### **SHADE HOUSE, CARPORT, FIBREGLASS & WELDING**

1. Supply, repair and install new shed net in a shade house no.1,2& 8(390SQM)

##### **MATERIALS**

- Supply and Install shade nets that are typically made from high density polyethylene (HDPE) due to its durability and resistance to UV rays. When choosing a material, consider:
  - UV Stabilisation: Ensure the net is UV stabilised to withstand prolonged exposure to sunlight.
- 2. Install existing shade net over a carport
- 3. Welding of six (6) containers.

Install and repair fibreglass roof in glasshouse no.1 & 7

##### **Sheet preparation and laying**

- Ensure the UV-protected side of the sheet faces the sun.
- Use a circular saw with a fine-tooth blade or an angle grinder with a cutting disc.
- Lay sheets starting from lower edge(eaves) and work upwards towards the r
- Use corrosion-resistant screws with rubber washers(e.g 90mm tech screws).
- Fix the sheets on top of the crest/roll to minimize leakage, using approximately 3 to 4 fasteners per square metre.
- Do not over-tighten fasteners, as this can crack the fibreglass and prevent washer from sealing correctly.

##### **Safety and maintenance**

- Wear gloves, safety goggles and a mask during cutting and installation.
- Handle with care to prevent cracking.
- Clean the roof with soapy water to maintain light transmission, avoiding harsh chemical cleaners.

**Conditions of Informal Tender**

1. Informal tender is open for all CIDB 1 (GB) and higher contractors.
  - 1.1 A copy of the Active CIDB registration or Registration Number to be submitted as a returnable schedule.
  - 1.2 Verification of Active CIDB registration will be done on the day of scoring

Take note that this is a percentage of the amount to do the works for unexpected / unforeseen events, which gets deducted from the offered price if not required.
