Scope of work

Bids are invited from interested parties for repairs, emergency or essential work to the fibre optic network for Electricity and Energy Directorate of the Nelson Mandela Bay Municipality. The scope only includes work relating to fibre optics associated with power system protection and electricity power network communications, as and when required until 30 June 2027 or budgetary/procurement threshold is reached, or contract is put in place whichever one occurs first.

The work to be carried out to the existing Electricity and Energy utility fibre optic network includes fault finding, repairs, testing, marking and commissioning into the existing network.

Requirements

- The tenderer must have able to respond to calls within an hour from after a callout was received.
- The successful tenderer must be available for call-out 24 hours a day including weekends.
- The tenderer must have in his/her employ qualified permanent staff, which shall include a certified fibre optic technician, to perform the required work on the fibre network.
- The tenderer shall have a minimum of three years' experience in the work specified.
- The tenderer shall have a Responsible Person who passed the HV Regulations exam in its employ. This is a requirement to enter HV/MV substations. A valid certificate or official proof from Electricity and Energy Directorate to be included with the tenderer's submission.
- The tenderer must have a minimum of two vehicles in order for them to respond to multiple call outs as and when required.
- All tenderers will provide their own necessary equipment to conduct all work on the fibre network which must be correctly calibrated and in working order.
- The successful tenderer will comply with all provisions of the OHS Act, as well as all safety rules of the Electricity and Energy Directorate. Health and safety file to be submitted prior to commencement of work.
- The tenderer must conform to the Construction Regulations as published under the Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) Act, Regulations 4 & 6 where applicable.
- A job card shall be submitted with every invoice and must reflect both the signature of the NMBM representative as well as the tenderer/tender's employee responsible for the project.
